Update – 15th December 2020

Meeting with Grange Park Parish Council, Amazon Grange Park and Northamptonshire County Council.

Julie and Tracy from Grange Park Parish Council (GPPC) met with Northamptonshire County Council (NCC) and Jonathan (Operations Manager) from Amazon yesterday afternoon (14th December 2020). The outcome of the meeting is as follows:

- The NCC propose double yellow lines down both sides of the road on Saxon Avenue (the section at the side of Amazon between the Coop roundabout and the roundabout by Amazon).
- The grass verges will be reinstated along the stretch of Saxon Avenue explained above.

Amazon have agreed to pay for both the above changes. GPPC will be providing Amazon with a quotation from our environment contractors for the grass verge reinstatement work. GPPC will oversee this work.

Please note: Due to the nature of the work, both the yellow lines and grass verge reinstatement will take place in Spring 2021.

Jonathan at Amazon informed us that at present they have 1000 drivers per day collecting deliveries. This will apparently reduce to 300 per day in the new year.

Amazon will also have access to a holding area at one of the warehouses on Cheaney Drive from the new year.

We have received a direct email address from Amazon for any resident issues or concerns regarding Amazon and their delivery drivers.
