Update – 15th April 2021

Virtual meeting with local businesses, Grange Park Parish Council (GPPC) and Local Residents

Thank you to all the local businesses, local residents and charitable organisations that attended the virtual Community Matters Meeting on 15th April 2021. Please see below the main points raised at the meeting:

- We were introduced to the new team at Amazon Grange Park. Amazon have made payment for the installation of the yellow lines to the Highways department and the consultation period for the installation of double yellow lines is in progress. This progress will take between 6 – 9 months.
- Grass seeding of the grass verges on Saxon Avenue will take place shortly. Further information to be provided by Amazon to GPPC. GPPC will then inform the local residents with the date of the works. The reinstatement work is paid for by Amazon.
- New email address for residents complaints and concerns to be provided by Amazon to GPPC. GPPC to inform local residents of the new contact details once they have received this information from Amazon.
- Amazon to investigate the issue of traffic congestion.
- Clipper is continuing to regularly litter pick the bus stop and have installed large cigarette bins within the area.
- Clipper are liaising with Stagecoach regarding any issues with their workers using the local buses.
- Clipper agreed to complete a litter pick of Sandy Lane.
- Thank you to all the local businesses who have shown support for the forthcoming Summer Festival, GPPC will be in contact with the businesses in due course.
- Thank you to Steve Curtess who is setting up a fundraising page for the installation of defibrillators within Grange Park. Thank you to all the local businesses who have shown their support to this fundraising activity.
