### Actions moving forward:

#### Clipper:

- Clipper will be continuing to complete daily litter picks around the bus stop (near Richmond Village entrance to Grange Park).
- Continuing to support the Grange Park Community Litter Pick as well as other local groups and organisations.
- Currently investigating the purchase of larger cigarette bins for the bus stop.
- Clipper to speak with their workers regarding road safety.

#### Amazon:

- A meeting has been arranged with Northamptonshire County Council (NCC) Highways, GPPC and Amazon, to be held before Christmas, to assess the grass verges on Saxon Avenue. To also review the issues with the litter around the bus stop, landscaping and congestion on the roads. **Please note:** the decision and action taken regarding the grass verges is made by NCC.
- The delivery vehicles currently have a holding area off site to wait at before their delivery slot at Grange Park. The delivery vehicles should be using this area. We understand that it will take a little while for this message to filter to all the delivery drivers. If you notice any vehicles parking along Saxon Avenue, please, if possible, provide a photo and vehicle registration number.
